NAME CHANGE:

Current Name: Agricultural Communication (B.S.A.)

Proposed Name: Agricultural and Environmental Science Communication (B.S.A.)

JUSTIFICATION:

The Department of Agricultural Leadership, Education, and Communication (ALEC) proposes a name change to the major in Agricultural Communication (B.S.A.). In working with the ALEC Advisory Board and others, it has been brought to the department's attention there is a need to be more inclusive and transparent in the types of industries this major prepares graduates to enter; therefore, the new proposed major name would be Agricultural and Environmental Science Communication (B.S.A.).

The curriculum already highlights the importance of both agricultural and environmental sciences. Each of the ten courses in the program utilize the naming nomenclature "agricultural and environmental sciences," such as AGCM 3400W, Writing for Agricultural and Environmental Sciences. The proposed major name would be more transparent for students and stakeholders to identify how graduates of the program are uniquely trained to positively engage in these industry sectors.

Based on the approved names of courses offered within the program, the proposed name does not infringe upon any other programs currently offered at UGA. The AESC prefix is already used within the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences; therefore, there is no proposed prefix changes for this major name change.

The department looks forward to being able to promote this program in recruiting efforts for the College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences (CAES) and working toward the college's strategic goals to increase student enrollment. Faculty also are excited about how this proposed name change can positively impact students' preparation to effectively communicate about the complex sciences emerging from the elite researchers at CAES and UGA.
