Proposal to deactivate the minor in Child and Family Development

Proposal to deactivate the major in Landscape and Grounds Management (B.S.A.)

The committee discussed the proposal to deactivate the major in Landscape and Grounds Management under the B.S.A. There was concern that paperwork provided was not sufficient to vote on the proposal, and a motion was made to table the proposal. The motion was denied.
