After much discussion, the committee denied a request to offer the major in Educational Leadership (Ed.D.) on the Griffin campus.

The committee tabled a request to offer a new Undergraduate Certificate in Entrepreneurship in Family and Consumer Sciences. The committee requested that the College of Family and Consumer Sciences meet with the Terry College of Business to discuss the proposal and possibly collaborate with the Management Department before the proposal is considered by the UCC.

The committee approved a request for the following new Areas of Emphasis under the major in Public Health (M.P.H.):

Area of Emphasis in Disaster Management Area of Emphasis in Gerontology

After much discussion, the committee denied a request to change the plus/minus grading scale to include A+.

The committee tabled a request to revise the High-Demand Selection Criteria for the major in Management Information Systems (B.B.A.). The committee requested that the proposal be revised to clarify whether the courses in the additional criteria are required or optional.
