For the remaining 3 credits, internship/service learning students will be enrolled in SPAN 3020, 3040, 4080, or 4082. Courses will be taught in the morning (9-11am) and in the afternoon (2-4pm), with one 3000-level and one 4000-level course taught in the morning and one of each in the afternoon. Final arrangements for course scheduling will be made immediately prior to the start of the UGABA program in the days preceding students arrival in Buenos Aires.
