The subcommittee approved the following course to fulfill the Experiential Learning Requirement and to be included as an option on the Experiential Learning Transcript:

Warnell School of Forestry and Natural Resources
FORS 4650/6650, Forestry Field Camp (*Global*)

The subcommittee denied the following course to fulfill the Experiential Learning Requirement and to be included as an option on the Experiential Learning Transcript:

College of Education
EPSY 2000-2000L, Science and Practice of Health and Well-Being (*Creative*)

The subcommittee determined that the course was too internalized and had no outward, public facing component. The subcommittee recommended revising the course to include an outward public facing component, such as a presentation, and then resubmit the course for consideration.

The following information items were presented to the subcommittee:

The College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences requested the following amendment to the college's Experiential Learning Plan. These non-credit activities were previously approved by the Experiential Learning Subcommittee to appear as options on the Experiential Learning Transcript:

- Augusta National Golf Club Internships (*Office of Instruction; Creative*)
- Reacting to the Past Peer Mentor (*Office of Instruction; Leadership*)
- Student Idea Showcase (*Office of Instruction; Creative*)

The subcommittee discussed and determined that EL certification officers cannot approve UGA course substitutions for the EL requirement. All course substitutions must be considered by the EL subcommittee.
