This is to indicate unanimous support of the faculty of the Department of Language and Literacy Education to change the name of the existing Educational Specialist Program in English Education to Educational Specialist Program in Language and Literacy Education. This name change parallels a similar request we made when out proposal to create a single department-wide PhD program was approved in 2005.

Along with supporting this name change from Educational Specialist in English Education to Educational Specialist in Language and Literacy Education, LLED faculty intend to request termination of two other existing Educational Specialist degree programs currently offered by the department. These are Educational Specialist degree programs in Reading Education and Teaching of Additional Languages. Students currently enrolled in one of the three existing degree programs will be "grandfathered" through graduation unless they choose to change their degree objective to the proposed department-wide Specialist Program.
