Dear Professor Shipley and Committee Members:

The Terry College Entrepreneurship program will be moved from the Management Department to the Management Information Systems (MIS) Department, effective FY 2015. All entrepreneurship courses, faculty and programs will become part of MIS at that time.

As such, the "MGMT" prefix will no longer be appropriate for entrepreneurship courses. We are requesting permission from the University Curriculum Committee to create a new prefix, "ENTR" (Entrepreneurship). If the new prefix is approved, separate CAPA requests will be made to change several undergraduate and MBA-level courses from the MGMT prefix to the ENTR prefix, including:
