Dear Dr. Ruppersburg:

Last Spring (on March 18, 2009), the faculty of the Department of Theatre and Film Studies voted to replace the course prefix for the department, which is currently DRAM, with two separate prefixes: THEA and FILM. According to the Office of Curriculum Systems, the process for effecting this change begins with our submitting a request, along with justification for the change, through your office.

The FILM prefix is to be used for courses offered by the department that are requirements or electives for the Film Studies B.A. degree. Courses that count just toward the Theatre major would adopt the THEA prefix, as would (at least for the time being) elective courses that count toward both majors. A list of the courses to be assigned to each of the new prefixes is enclosed.

The motivation for this change is twofold. First, as you know, the department changed its name from "Drama and Theatre" to "Theatre and Film Studies" several years ago, reflecting the department's dual emphasis on theatre and film, but our prefix has continued to be DRAM. Since the word "drama" no longer appears anywhere in our department name, the prefix is confusing and inconsistent. Second, now that we have a distinct Film Studies major, a distinct FILM prefix will make course requirements clearer to current Film Studies majors, and will make the transcripts of our majors easier for graduate programs in Film to interpret.
