1. Area of Emphasis Title: Global Health

2. Area of Emphasis Description:

The Graduate Certificate in Global Health program has a long, solid history and the number of students involved has steadily increased in recent years. Creating an Area of Emphasis in Global Health under the Master of Public Health (M.P.H.) degree will expand the global health academic program to better meet the growing workforce training needs. The curriculum is a merging of existing global health courses and other College of Public Health courses, so no additional resources will be required to offer this degree.
