## 1. Area of Emphasis Description:

The Bachelor of Arts degree in Romance Languages (A.B.), with an Area of Emphasis in Portuguese and Brazilian Studies, provides in-depth study of the Portuguese language and the culture and literature of the Lusophone (Portuguese-speaking) world, including Brazil, Portugal, Lusophone Africa, and their respective immigrant communities in North America. Coursework addresses formal language instruction from novice to advanced levels, as well as distinct literary genres and traditions of the Lusophone world, both within a broad cultural and socio-historical framework to better understand their current relevance. This degree may be complemented by weekly tutorials, telecollaborative learning, internship placement, service-learning, and study abroad in Brazil through the Flagship program and other opportunities. This degree helps prepare graduates for careers in education, international relations, international business, public service, and other professions that require strong linguistic and cultural competency.

The Area of Emphasis in Portuguese and Brazilian Studies requires 27 credit hours. A minimum grade of "C" (2.0) is required in course work for this major.
