JUSTIFICATION:

The current area of emphasis title, Teaching Advanced Mathematics, was chosen when there were a number of students in Mathematics Education (B.S.Ed.) who were not interested in becoming certified to teach in grades 6-12, which is the primary goal of the major. This title has caused confusion for students who think the area of emphasis is for those who want to teach precalculus and calculus in high schools.

Every other undergraduate major in the College of Education offers an Area of Emphasis in Educational Studies relevant to the specific program. Changing the name of this area of emphasis to Educational

Studies in Mathematics Education will align the Mathematics Education (B.S.Ed.) with the rest of the college and decrease confusion for students.
