The subcommittee unanimously approved the requests for the following courses to be included in the list of courses that satisfy the Environmental Awareness requirement:

The subcommittee unanimously denied the requests for the following courses to be included in the list of courses that satisfy the Environmental Awareness requirement due to insufficient evidence in the CAPA course objectives and topical outlines that the courses meet the Environmental Awareness learning outcomes:
