We are requesting a name change for the doctoral program currently called Counseling and Student Personnel Services in the Department of Counseling and Human Development Services. The program received its current name in 1990 and the nomenclature of the field of student affairs has changed considerably since that time. Our masters program is called College Student Affairs Administration, and we would like to use the same name for the doctoral program. The term "student personnel" dates back to the early literature of our profession and does not reflect today's language or mission. The program faculty are unanimous in this recommendation.

I understand that this recommendation must be approved by the department, the Dean, the Graduate School, the University Curriculum Committee, the University Council, and the President. We would like to be able to implement this change as soon as all approvals have been granted.
