Dear Professor Shipley,

The Warnell School of Forestry and Natural Resources would like to request that the following Areas of Emphasis within the Forestry major of our Bachelor's of Science in Forest Resources degree program be terminated:

Forest Administration and Policy Forest Biology Forest Business Forest Management Forest Recreation Urban Forestry

We eliminated all Areas of Emphasis during our curriculum revision a few years ago in an effort to improve uniformity within each of our majors, but for some reason a formal request to terminate these Areas of Emphasis within the Forestry major was never completed. There are no students enrolled in any Area of Emphasis within the Forestry major, nor have there been any for at least two years. There is no impact on the teaching assignments or contributions of any Warnell faculty, as there have never been any courses whose offering was dependant upon an active Area of Emphasis. The Forestry major Areas of Emphasis are merely overlooked relics of our old curriculum, and terminating them will eliminate a source of confusion over the nature of our program offerings.
