Experiential learning is an important part of training public health professionals for the future and is an essential part of our public health courses. The College of Public Health has embraced experiential learning in a variety of ways including internships, study abroad, service-learning, and supervised research courses. The majority of our students participate in multiple experiences as part of their course of study.
