The Experiential Learning Subcommittee met on September 23, 2025, at 4:00 p.m. via Zoom.

The subcommittee unanimously approved the minutes of the May 6, 2025, Experiential Learning Subcommittee meeting.

The subcommittee discussed the course ANTH 3620, Action and Adventure in Anthropology (*Creative*), which was considered at a previous meeting. At that time, the subcommittee recommended that the course be revised and re-submitted for Service-Learning instead of the Creative category. After revisions, the course was resubmitted by the department for consideration for the Creative category again.

After discussion, the subcommittee unanimously approved the course ANTH 3620, Action and Adventure in Anthropology, from the Franklin College of Arts and Sciences to satisfy the Experiential Learning Requirement for the Creative category.

The subcommittee unanimously approved the course, CBIO 2300, Communicating Human Anatomy and Physiology, from the Franklin College of Arts and Sciences to satisfy the Experiential Learning Requirement for the Service category.

The subcommittee unanimously denied the course, HIST(POLS)(INTL) 5800, Applied History Internship, from the Franklin College of Arts and Sciences to satisfy the Experiential Learning Requirement for the Internship category. The subcommittee recommended the department add additional information for each element in the Experiential Learning form. Once updated, the course can be resubmitted for consideration.

The subcommittee unanimously approved the MARK 4210E, Professional Selling and Customer Relationship Management, from the Terry College of Business to satisfy the Experiential Learning Requirement for the Leadership category.
