The Environmental Awareness Subcommittee of the University Curriculum Committee met on January 20, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. via Zoom.

The subcommittee unanimously approved the minutes of the October 12, 2021, meeting.

The subcommittee unanimously approved the request to include MARS 3100, Oceans in Peril, in the list of courses that fulfill the University-wide Environmental Awareness Requirement.

The subcommittee unanimously denied the request to include MARS 3200, Fundamentals of Ocean Science, in the list of courses that fulfill the University-wide Environmental Awareness Requirement. The subcommittee determined there was insufficient evidence in the CAPA course description, course objectives, and topical outline that the course met the requirement of focusing a significant amount of time on the interactions between human activity and the environment.
