The General Education Subcommittee of the University Curriculum Committee met on February 22, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. via Zoom.

The subcommittee unanimously approved the minutes of the January 29, 2021 meeting.

Dr. William Vencill provided an update regarding the discussions being held by the University System of Georgia concerning General Education. The University System of Georgia will request formal approval from the Board of Regents so that UGA can move ahead with the proposed new General Education Curriculum plan.

The Subcommittee discussed possible revisions to the proposed General Education Curriculum plan to better align with new System guidelines for general education.

Dr. William Vencill agreed to approach Franklin College to discuss changes in the proposed General Education Curriculum plan and the Franklin College Requirements.

The draft proposal for the new General Education Core Curriculum will continue to be discussed at the next General Education Subcommittee meeting scheduled for March 19, 2021.
