The General Education Subcommittee of the University Curriculum Committee met on September 23, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. in 315 New College.

The subcommittee unanimously approved the minutes of the July 29, 2024, General Education Subcommittee meeting.

The subcommittee unanimously approved the following course from the School of Ecology to be added to list of courses approved to satisfy Area III, Quantitative Reasoning, of the General Education Core Curriculum:

ECOL 2550, Introduction to Ecological Data Science

The subcommittee unanimously approved the following course from the College of Engineering to be added to list of courses approved to satisfy Area III, Quantitative Reasoning, of the General Education Core Curriculum:

ECSE 2170-2170L, Fundamentals of Circuit Analysis

The subcommittee considered the following course from the School of Ecology to be added to list of courses approved to satisfy Area II, Life Sciences, of the General Education Core Curriculum. They did not reach a decision, and it will be reconsidered at the next meeting.

ECOL 2000, Our Planet: Ecological Basis of Life and Death

The General Education subcommittee discussed next steps for the proposed revisions of undergraduate education at the University of Georgia. The discussion included a review of the campus fora, held on September 16, 2024, and September 19, 2024, where the proposed revisions to undergraduate education were presented to students, faculty, and staff. The subcommittee discussed where 18 credit hours of the Area VI courses will appear in the revised general education. It was determined that 78 credit hours includes 18 credit hours of major related courses (formerly Area VI courses) and 60 hours of major required courses.
