The General Education Subcommittee of the University Curriculum Committee met on September 2, 2021, at 9:00 a.m. via Zoom.

The subcommittee approved minutes of the March 19, 2021, General Education Subcommittee meeting.

Dr. Mauricio welcomed Dr. Briggs as a new subcommittee member and provided background on the subcommittee duties and General Education policies.

The subcommittee unanimously denied the requests to include the following courses in the list of courses that satisfy the General Education Core Curriculum. The subcommittee determined the scope of the courses was too narrow to satisfy the General Education Core Curriculum:

Area II, Life Sciences

PATH 1103E, Plant Microbiology
PATH 1113E, Plant Microbiology Laboratory Online

The subcommittee unanimously approved the request to include the following course in the list of courses that satisfy the General Education Core Curriculum:

Area IV, Humanities and the Arts

MUSI 2600, Introduction to Media Music

The subcommittee unanimously denied the request to include the following course in the list of courses that satisfy the General Education Core Curriculum. The subcommittee determined the course does not meet the General Education Learning Outcomes for the core area for which it was submitted for consideration.


Area V, Social Sciences

The subcommittee discussed a student appeal to satisfy Area IV, World Languages and Culture, with AMSL 1010, AMSL 1020, AMSL 2010, and/or AMSL 2020. After discussion, the subcommittee voted to deny the request. The subcommittee response will be sent to the Educational Affairs Committee.
