## • Major Banner Upgrade: Banner 9 Timeline:

- Ellucian is asking all of its clients to upgrade to a new generation of Banner called Banner
  This is a major upgrade with many changes, especially in the graphic interface.
- The INB portion of Banner will go to production in November 2018, and the SSB (or Athena) portion will happen in early spring 2019.
- The Registrar's Office is requesting of RAC members to provide the forms that are most commonly used in INB Banner. This information will then be considered when the Registrar's Office begins work on training materials for Banner 9. RAC members are encouraged to provide the Registrar's Office with this information.

## • Course Levels at Registration:

## • Spring Commencement Information:

- The Registrar's Office is currently in the process of editing the spring commencement programs with Bulldog Printing. The programs will soon be going to print.

- Because construction is currently underway at Gate 10 at Sanford Stadium, undergraduate students will be entering the stadium through either Gate 2 or Gate 9. The Registrar's Office plans to email undergraduate students who have applied for spring and summer 2018 graduation what gate they will be coming through to line up by school/college for the processional. This information will also be posted on the commencement website.
- As a reminder, spring grades are due May 7 at 12:00 noon.
- On May 8, graduation rosters for spring will open. The Registrar's Office will award degrees on the same rolling cycle as was done for fall 2017.

## • Incoming Fall 2018 Class- ArchPass Duo:
