

## How to Calculate Remaining General Electives in DegreeWorks

**General Electives** are courses that count toward your required degree credit total but do not satisfy specific requirements for your program of study.

The **Degree** card near the top of the audit shows the total number of General Elective credits required for your degree program. This includes all General Elective requirements in the degree audit and may vary by student.

## What are Excess Credits in DegreeWorks?

**Excess Credits** are credits earned that do not satisfy any specific requirements for your program of study and do not count toward your 'Credits Applied' total.

Once your 'Credits Applied' in the GE card = 'GE Credits Required' in the Degree card, earned credits not satisfying specific program of study requirements will appear as Excess Credits directly below the General Electives card.
