



How to Calculate Remaining General Electives in DegreeWorks

General Electives are courses that count toward your required degree credit total but do not satisfy specific requirements for your program of study.

The **Degree** card near the top of the audit shows the total number of General Elective credits required for your degree program. This includes all General Elective requirements in the degree audit and may vary by student.

To calculate your remaining General Elective (GE) credits:

Subtract the number of GE Credits Applied from the number of GE Credits Required.

Formula	Student Example
GE Credits Required	20
- GE Credits Applied	- 5
GE Credits Remaining	15



What are Excess Credits in DegreeWorks?

Excess Credits are credits earned that do not satisfy any specific requirements for your program of study and do not count toward your 'Credits Applied' total.

Once your '**Credits Applied**' in the **GE card** = '**GE Credits Required**' in the **Degree card**, earned credits not satisfying specific program of study requirements will appear as **Excess Credits** directly below the **General Electives** card.
