The subcommittee unanimously approved the minutes of the November 24, 2025, Experiential Learning Subcommittee meeting.

The subcommittee unanimously approved the following courses to be included as options for Experiential Learning:

College of Agricultural and Environmental Sciences

FDST 4250/6250-4250L/6250L, Food Product Development (*Creative*)  
RBIO 3910, Regenerative Bioscience Internship I (*Internship*)

College of Engineering

ENGR 3930, Internship in Engineering (*Internship*)
